The vision for the Asian Pacific Children's Fund was birthed in 2002 when APCF President and founder Don McAlvany and his wife Molly encountered an orphan's home on Manila Bay in the Philippines. The children in this home had come from very difficult backgrounds: from the streets of Philippine cities where they begged, stole, or sold their bodies to stay alive; from poor villages where they had lost one or both parents; from abject poverty, abuse, and rejection; and from lives with no hope and no future.

Asian Pacific Children's Fund's mission is to find, evaluate, and "adopt" well run existing orphan and children homes in the developing world, especially Asia, increase their visibility, and help bring in funding from individuals, businesses, charitable foundations, churches and any other group with a heart for these children.
